FLIPT – Intercultural Festival Laboratory of Theatre Practise, organized by **Teatro Potlach**, in Fara Sabina, is now in its 17th edition.

Sixteen days of workshops, shows and dialogues about the creative exchange between different cultures of performance. At the centre the actor: in theatre, in cinema and in the new media.

This year the comparison will take place between artists from **Indonesia, Iran, Denmark, USA, Brazil, Hungary** and **Italy**, which will give the festival their own contribution through the sharing of their personal theatrical experience.

From **23th June to 9th July**, at Teatro Potlach, directed by **Pino Di Buduo**, international pedagogues will conduct workshops on directing and on the core elements of the actor's stage presence in Eastern and Western cultures.

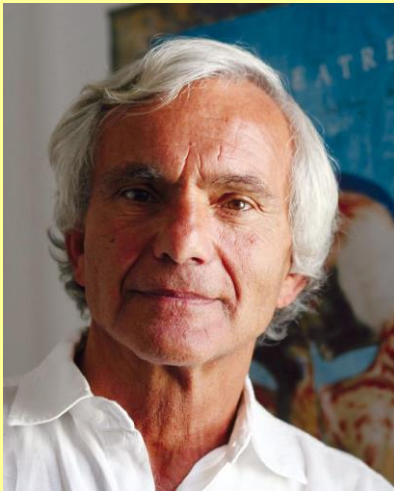

EUGENIO BARBA (Denmark)

He was born in Italy and emigrated to Norway to work as a welder and a sailor. He went to Poland to learn at the State Theatre School, but one year later he met Jerzy Grotowski and remained with him for three years. When Barba returned to Oslo, he became a professional theatre director and he gathered together a few young people who had not been accepted by the State Theatre School, and created Odin Teatret in 1964. They were subsequently invited by the Danish municipality of Holstebro, to create a theatre laboratory there. During the past fifty years Eugenio Barba has directed 76 productions with Odin Teatret and with the intercultural Theatrum Mundi Ensemble. In 1979 Eugenio Barba founded ISTA, International School of Theatre Anthropology, thus opening a new field of studies: Theatre Anthropology. His publications, translated into many languages, are copious.



JULIA VARLEY (Denmark)

Actress, teacher, organizer and writer. With Odin Teatret she teaches in schools and universities. Since 1990 she has been involved in the conception and organization of ISTA (International School of Theatre Anthropology) and of the University of Eurasian Theatre, both directed by Eugenio Barba. Since its beginning in 1986 she has been active in The Magdalena Project, a network of women in contemporary theatre. She is also artistic director of Transit International Festival (Holstebro) and editor of The Open Page, a journal devoted to women's work in theatre.



I WAYAN BAWA (Bali)

He is son of I Nyoman Sadeg, a renowned interpreter of the masked dance drama Topeng. Since his youth he has studied Gambuh, Topeng and Tjalonarang, the drama of magic, under the guidance of I Made Djimat, one of the great Balinese dance masters. He has also been a student of the Dance Academy in Denpasar, STSI, and now is the artistic director and main teacher for the male roles of the Gambuh Desa Batuan Ensemble. He has collaborated with ISTA since 1995 and is a permanent member of the Theatrum Mundi Ensemble



CLAUDIO DE MAGLIO (Italy)

Actor, director, playwright. Behind his formation there are great names of Theatre, Dance and Pantomime: Scuola Nuova Scena of Bologna directed by Alessandra Galante, Eduardo De Filippo, Carolyn Carlson, Alwin Nikolais, and many more... All this in a directive that connects the body with the voice, where the actor is organicity. From 1991 he is the director of Civica Accademia d'Arte Drammatica "Nico Pepe" in Udine. He conducts constantly masterclass all over the world.
